How proposals are built

Proposals reflect:

- District size and enrollment
- Academic priorities and intervention goals
- Subject demand
- Reporting needs
- Program duration and scheduling requirements

Example partnership models

Pilot Partnership

Small-scale implementation designed to establish referral processes and evaluate demand. Ideal for a focused grade band, subject area, or single-school launch before broader expansion.

Standard Partnership

District-wide supplemental academic support with recurring reporting and ongoing tutoring availability across agreed subjects and schools.

Expanded Partnership

Comprehensive academic support with greater tutoring capacity, expanded reporting, and additional services such as enhanced Power BI Dashboard Options and more frequent partnership reviews.

Partnerships may include

- Annual tutoring allocations
- Referral management and tutor matching

- Monthly reporting and Power BI Dashboard Options
- Quarterly reviews
- Flexible scheduling
- Additional tutoring capacity
- Optional rollover provisions

Every proposal is individually prepared after consultation with district leadership. Program structure, included services, and investment are determined during that process.
